



# **NORTH AREA ATHLETICS COMPLEX**

**Location of Field:** 19500 W. 64<sup>th</sup> Parkway, Arvada. From Kipling north, follow 64<sup>th</sup> Avenue west to 64<sup>th</sup> Parkway to Highway 93. Stadium is on the SE corner of 64<sup>th</sup> Parkway and Highway 93. Or take Hwy. 93 north from Golden to 64<sup>th</sup> Pkwy, and turn east.

## **Visitor's Team Bench:**

- Soccer: both teams are on the West Side.
- Football: East Side

## **Visitor Seating:**

- Football: East side of the stadium... The east side ticket booth is located on the southeast corner of the stadium. There is no access to visitor seating from the main entrance on the west side of the stadium.
- Soccer: For most events all seating will be on the west stands of the soccer field.

**Medical TimeOut:** 15 minutes prior to the start of the game there will be a medical timeout for administration from each team and one coach, along with trainers from both sides. **Headsets:** Two phones are available in each spotter's booth. Visiting team's phones are in the west press box. Field phone system is a Telex system and has the capabilities of splitting offense and defense. The splitting switch is located in the spotter's booth.

**Press Box:** The press box is a working area for gameworkers and coaches only. There is no space available for non-stadium personnel.

**Media Coverage:** Cable or radio coverage must be cleared through Ezra Paddock, 720-331-7289. CHSAA guidelines will be followed.

**Buses:** Team buses enter the stadium grounds through the gate at the NW corner of the complex. Band buses may also enter at this gate. All other buses (student, spectator, etc.) must park in the designated area in the south lot.

**Playing Field:** NAAC has two playing surfaces (football & soccer). Both fields are a sand-base natural grass playing surface.

**Locker Rooms:** East side of the football stadium. Teams can arrive 1.5 hours before game time.

**Visitors** - south locker rm. **Home** - north locker rm.

*\*\*\* Teams traveling long distances, who change after arrival, need to make special arrangements with the home team's athletics director. Teams need to bring towels if they plan to shower.*

**Team Warm-up:** **Visitors** – south end of field. **Home** – north end of field.

**Football & Lacrosse: National Anthem and Coin Flip:** The coin flip will take place five (5) minutes prior to game time. The National Anthem will be played three (3) minutes prior to game time and we request that all players and team personnel stand in front of their designated benches.

**Soccer: National Anthem - Coin Flip - Starting Lineups:** The clock to conclude warmups will end approximately 7 minutes prior to the posted start time of each game. During the 7 minute period between the conclusion of warmups and the start of the game the National Anthem will be played, the officials will conduct the coin toss, and the starting line-ups will be announced. We request that all players and team personnel stand in front of their designated benches during the playing of the national anthem.

**Team Colors:** **Home Team** – Dark Uniforms. **Visiting Teams** – White Uniforms.

**Game Video:** Jefferson County films all home contests in HUDL. Film will be shared with the home team.

**Ambulance:** Ambulance service is within five (5) minutes of the facility. Expenses incurred for use will be the responsibility of the requesting school or party.

**Tickets and Passes:** CHSAA Passes are accepted for all regular season and playoffs games.

Jeffco Athletics has partnered with GoFan digital ticketing for varsity athletics events. Fans can purchase tickets one of three ways:

Fans are encouraged to buy tickets online prior to arriving at the facility. For your convenience, signage will be set up at the venue to help fans navigate an online purchase quickly and easily.

Ticket booths are open 1 hour prior to game time (sales & entry)

Regular season ticket prices are as follows:

- \$6.25 All Spectators
- JPS High & Middle School Students with an Activity Pass are admitted for FREE
- Jeffco Athletics has a **no re-entry** policy during the course of the game

**Tobacco Free:** The use of tobacco by students, teachers, staff and visitors in or on any school property, or at any student activity sponsored by the school district, is prohibited.

**Alcohol & Marijuana:** Use or possession of marijuana or alcohol is NOT permitted on any Jeffco property, including stadiums. Spectators are not allowed to bring outside food or beverages into Jeffco stadiums. This includes but is not limited to water bottles and carbonated beverages in cans or bottles.

**\*\*\* Backpacks are not permitted in the stadiums, and carry bags may be subject to search upon stadium entry.**

**Noisemakers:** Sports specific CHSAA guidelines on noisemakers will be followed throughout the course of the contest and for the entire duration of the season.

**Banners:** A school's official banner may be displayed. (Avoid using duct tape because it removes paint from railings.) Solicitation is not allowed on the premises.

**Animals:** Service animals are permitted. No pets are allowed.
